


Daily Life - Handyman (C0285)

on top of that	<i>P</i>	besides that
clog up	<i>P</i>	becomes blocked
wiring	<i>N</i>	the system of wires that carry electricity
fall apart	<i>P</i>	slowly break
gutter	<i>N</i>	long, hollow device that is attached to a roof

Supplementary Vocabulary

plumber	<i>N</i>	someone who installs the pipes, bathroom fixtures, and fixes toilets, sinks, etc.
electrician	<i>N</i>	someone who works with the electric wiring of a building
plunger	<i>N</i>	a rubber device that helps to unclog toilets

insulation *N*

material used to regulate temperature; keep a building warm in the winter and cool in the summer

gutter *N*

a channel on the side of a building or street that guides away surface water
